Tariff exemptions extended until 31 January 2025



The duty relief for private individuals will remain in force at least until 31 January 2025 (source: <u>D-Cuba</u>).

Cuba has <u>extended</u> duty-free private imports of food, hygiene products, medicines and medical devices until 31 January, 2025.

The limits remain unchanged at 50 kilograms or a value of 500 US dollars. For postal items sent by air or sea, the limit increased from 200 to 500 US dollars last summer also remains in force. For non-commercial mail containing food, hygiene products, medicines or medical devices, the first 20 kilograms with a value of no more than 200 US dollars are duty-free. For all other shipments, the first 30 US dollars up to 3 kilograms are duty-free, beyond that a customs tariff of 30 per cent applies.

The measure was originally introduced in July 2021 and has since been extended by six months at a time, <u>most recently</u> by three months at a time. This time, the period was extended by four months, which was slightly longer. However, it remains speculation as to whether this could indicate an end to the measure. (<u>Cubaheute</u>)
