FCS 1500-001: Extra Credit Opportunity

Below is a list of the songs I have played before our classes to date (October 8, 2010). You should be able to use the dates to determine the topic covered on that day (I also have provided information along these lines). The extra-credit opportunity is as follows:

Select two (2) songs from the list. For each, provide the lyrics for the song along with an explanation of the connection you see between the song and the topic covered the day the song was played. I expect your paper to demonstrate some level of insight regarding the manner in which the lyrics to the song are relevant to the topic of the class. The better able you are to express such insight, the more extra credit you will receive.

I will award a maximum of 12 points for this written assignment, at my discretion, based on the quality of your insights and your ability to communicate them in writing. These points will be added to your total points for the semester (the sum of your scores across the four exams) such that for a student receiving full credit for this assignment (12 points), this would be the equivalent of adding those 12 points to one of your exam scores. 12 points of extra credit would raise a student's final average by 3 points (to compute the final average, total points are divided by 4 because there are 4 exams), which in many cases would raise a student's grade to the next highest grade. For example, a student who has an average of 85% across the four exams would receive a B for this class. If that same student were to receive 12 points of extra credit, s/he would then have an average of 88% which would receive a B+.

Restrictions

- 1. Your paper must be typed and each explanation is limited to one typed page (lyrics don't count in this page count);
- 2. Your paper must be turned in to me at our first class after Fall break, which will be Monday, October 18. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this requirement;
- 3. I will not accept your paper via email—it must be handed to me.

This will be the only extra-credit opportunity I will offer for this course this semester. Only students who have attended class on the day I announce it will be able to take advantage of this opportunity.
