- ▶ Industrial revolution starts about 250 ya

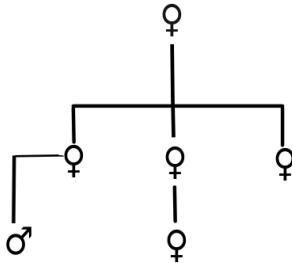

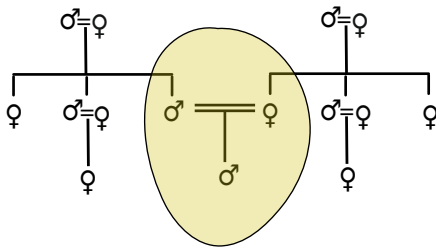

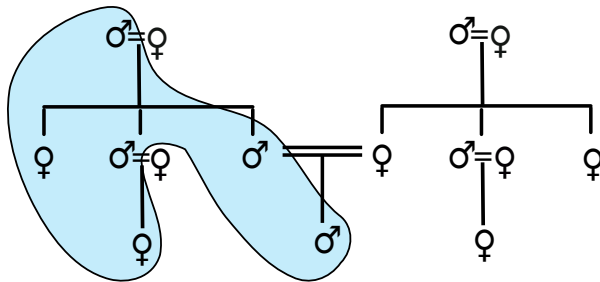
Nuclear Kinship System

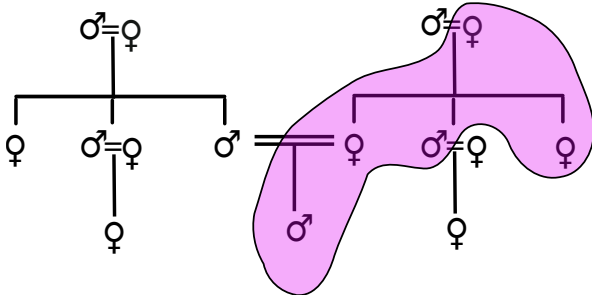
Patrilineal Kinship System

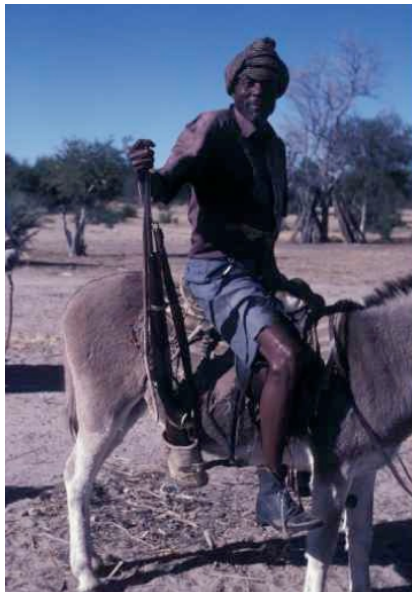
